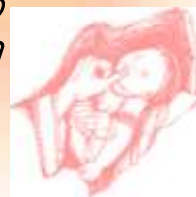

# Feasts and Memorials

## **Tuesday 18th June, 2024**

Memorial of St John Rigby,  
Martyr

Born at Harrock Hall, near Wigan. A servant martyred for being reconciled to the Catholic Church. Died at Southwark, 21st June, 1600.

## **Friday 21st June, 2024**

Memorial of St. Aloysius  
Gonzaga, SJ

*(Solemnity in St. Aloysius Parish)*

Aloysius was the son of the Marquis of Castiglione and his wife who was lady-in-waiting to the Queen of Spain. Destined for a military life, he suffered however from kidney disease which gave him leisure for prayer and reading the Lives of the Saints.

To his father's intense indignation and despite the attraction of the court, he became a Jesuit. Nursing the sick in the plague hospital he caught the disease and partially recovering he soon relapsed and died in 1591 aged 23.

## **Saturday 22nd June, 2024**

FEAST OF SS. JOHN FISHER,  
BISHOP AND MARTYR AND  
THOMAS MORE, MARTYR

John Fisher (1469-1535) a distinguished scholar (Chancellor of Cambridge University) whose theological works influenced the Council of Trent was Bishop of Rochester. A pastoral bishop, charitable to the poor, a man of prayer, and a persistent opponent of the errors of the Protestant Reformation, his high reputation made him an obvious choice as confessor to Henry VMI's queen Catharine of Aragon. He maintained the validity of Henry's marriage to Catherine. John refused to take the Oath of Supremacy and died a martyr, pardoning his executioner and declaring he was dying for Christ's holy Catholic Church. Whilst in prison John Fisher was made a cardinal by Pope Paul III. Thomas More (1478-1535), the son of a judge, became a barrister and after

holding various public offices he later became Lord Chancellor of England. Becoming embroiled, like John Fisher, in the controversy over Henry's marriage, he renounced the Chancellorship. The final crisis with the king came over the Act of Succession. Opposing the Act was considered high treason and Thomas was imprisoned for the then remaining 15 months of his life. He was executed on 6th July 1535, his last words being that he died for the faith of the Holy Catholic Church and was the 'king's good servant, but God's first'.

## **Wednesday 19th June, 2024**

Optional Memorial of St  
Romuald, Abbot

Saint Romuald was born in Ravenna, Italy to a family of nobility in the middle of the tenth century. Founder of the Camaldolese monks, he was a hermit and a reformer of the monastic custom of his time. He died after a life of prayer and rigorous penance around 1027.

## **Thursday 20th June, 2024**

Optional Memorial of St Alban,  
First Martyr of Britain  
3rd Century. Alban was a soldier and first martyr of England. Alban's cult spread links England, as no other cult, with the Church of the late Roman Empire. Alban suffered martyrdom in the amphitheatre outside the town of Verulamium (St Albans). St Bede says that Alban, a pagan soldier, sheltered by a priest, was converted by him and baptised. Refusing to offer sacrifice to pagan gods he was condemned to death.

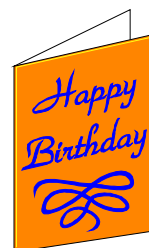
