



Other Feasts and Memorials

Tuesday 22nd October, 2024

Optional Memorial of
St John Paul II, Pope

Born in Poland .18th May 1920.

Became the first non-Italian pope in 455 years. An enormous influence both in the Church and in the world. Only history will tell of the enormity of that influence save to say that he truly deserves the title 'Great' that many have attached to him.

After the second longest papacy in modern times he died on 2nd April 2005, the Eve of the Feast of Divine Mercy, a devotion that he did much to promote in the Church.

Wednesday 23rd October, 2024

Optional Memorial of

St. John of Capestrano, Priest
John Capistrano was born in 1386. His

education was thorough. His talents and success were great. When he was 26 he

was made governor of Perugia. Imprisoned after a battle against the Malatestas, he resolved to change his way of life completely. At the age of 30 he entered the

Franciscan novitiate and was ordained a priest four years later. His preaching

attracted great throngs at a time of religious apathy and confusion. He and 12

Franciscan brethren were received in the countries of central Europe as angels of God. They were instrumental in reviving a dying faith and devotion. The Franciscan

Order itself was in turmoil over the interpretation and observance of the Rule of St. Francis. Through John's tireless

efforts and his expertise in law, the

heretical Fraticelli were suppressed and the "Spirituals" were freed from interference in

their stricter observance. He helped bring about a reunion with the Greek and

Armenian Churches, unfortunately only a brief arrangement.

When the Turks captured Constantinople in 1453, he was commissioned to preach a crusade for the defense of Europe. Gaining

little response in Bavaria and Austria, he decided to concentrate his efforts in

Hungary. He led the army to Belgrade.

Under the great General John Hunyadi, they gained an overwhelming victory, and the siege of Belgrade was lifted. Worn out by his superhuman efforts, Capistrano was an easy prey to an infection after the battle.

He died on October 23, 1456

Thursday 24th October, 2024

Optional Memorial of

St. Antony Mary Claret, Bishop
December 23, 1807 - October 24, 1870)

was a Catalan Spanish Roman Catholic archbishop and missionary, and was confessor of Isabella II of Spain. He

founded the congregation of Missionary Sons of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, commonly called the Claretians.

Saturday 26th October, 2024

Optional Memorial of

Ss. Chad & Cedd, Bishops

Chad, who died at Lichfield on 2nd March 672 and Cedd who died at Lastingham, Yorkshire on this day in 664 were brothers.

Both were educated at Lindisfarne under Aidan. Cedd was founder of many

monasteries. He was sent as a bishop to evangelise the East Saxons. He died of the

plague at his monastery in Lastingham. Chad was abbot of Lastingham and then

sent as bishop to Mercia, where he founded the see of Lichfield. Holiness of life,

outstanding humility, and dedication to preaching the Gospel are attributed to

St Chad.
