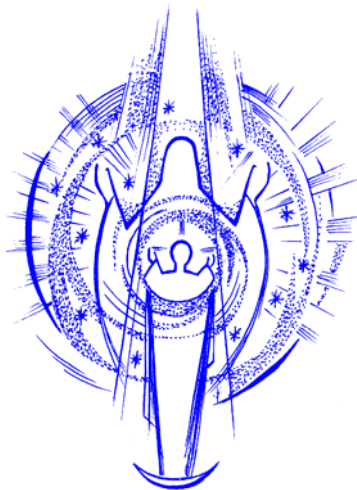

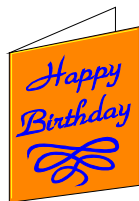

The 4th October this year will be the 10th anniversary of the death of the founder of Jospice, Father Francis O'Leary. As you are probably aware he worked for many years in South America opening clinics and hospices in the name of Jospice International, and over the years we have cared for many thousands of people in some of the poorest countries of the world who simply would not have been able to access any sort of healthcare. Jospice will be celebrating its Golden Jubilee in 2012 and we do need to focus more on the work we do in South America and the assistance we can give to some of the projects and centres we run.

Saturday, 9th October is also International Hospice Day and hospices around the world will be celebrating the work that is done within the hospice movement on every level of palliative care. Here at Jospice I am organising a walk along the Tolkien Trail'. This is a six mile scenic walk in the Ribble Valley skirting the walls of Stonyhurst College. There will be a coach laid on from Jospice in Thornton to the area, we will start with a cup of coffee and after the walk afternoon tea will be provided. It is hoped that a tour of Stonyhurst College will also be included after the walk.

We will probably leave the Crosby area about 10am and return about 5.30pm. I am asking a number of parishes in the Liverpool Archdiocese if any of their parishioners would be interested in taking part in this walk, obviously the transport and hospitality will be included, so it will make for quite a nice autumn day out. It is hoped that people taking part will be able to raise sponsorship monies from their friends and family and also from within the parish.
