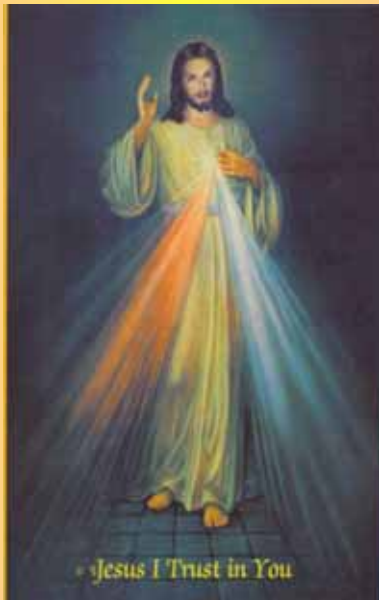
DIVINE MERCY

Wednesday 21st November 2018

Memorial of Presentation of the
Blessed Virgin Mary

Thursday 22nd November 2018

Memorial of St Cecilia, Virgin and
Martyr

Cecilia was a Roman martyr of the 3rd century. According to tradition she was a young Christian patrician, betrothed to a pagan. But she had already vowed her virginity to God and refused to consummate the marriage. Both her husband and his brother became Christians, were arrested, and martyred. Soon afterwards Cecilia was brought before the prefect. She refused to sacrifice to pagan gods, converted her persecutors, and was sentenced to suffocation. The plan failed and a soldier was sent to behead her. Three blows failed to kill her and she survived for three days.

23rd November - St Clement I Clement probably followed Peter as Bishop of Rome. His Epistle to the Corinthians suggests he knew Peter and Paul and reveals a man of strong faith and prayer.

Saturday 24th November 2018

Memorial of St. Andrew Dung-Lac,
Priest and Companions, Martyrs
martyrs in Vietnam from 1745 to 1862 - also
called Martyrs of Indo-China or of Tonkin.
They include both Europeans and Asians.

There were 8 bishops, 50 priests and 59
laymen. During the first 200 years of
Christianity in that part of the world it is
believed that about 100,000 were martyred.
During the persecutions, Christians were
marked on their faces with the words 'ta
dao' (false religion).

543 - 615. Well educated and desiring to
be a "pilgrim of God", Columban
travelled France and founded several

shipwreck directed him towards Rome
and to the founding of his final
monastery at Bobbio in Italy.
